

ART FAIR ASIA FUKUOKA President

The 8th "ART FAIR ASIA FUKUOKA 2023" was held for four days from September 21st to 24th at MARINE MESSE FUKUOKA Hall B, the biggest venue we ever had for the fair.

This year's AFAF2023 consisted of the largest number of 126 exhibitors and was co-hosted by Fukuoka City since last year and newly joined this year by the Culture Vision Japan Foundation Inc. Galleries from other Asian countries such as Taiwan, South Korea, Hong Kong, Vietnam, Malaysia, and the Philippines participated in the fair, making it an exciting international art fair that lives up to its name, ART FAIR ASIA FUKUOKA.

Around the same time as the fair, Fukuoka was decorated with art with "FaN Week" and satellite events held in the city, Fukuoka Airport, and Hakata Station Square.

AFAF will continue to work closely with Fukuoka City, which aims to be a leader city in Asia, to create an art fair that bridges the Japanese and Asian art markets.

We hope that through the power of art, the city will become more prosperous culturally and economically and exchange and foster diversity and creativity. We wish to assist in some







This year's fair featured not only "Asia" but also "Kyushu" as the theme, and booths were set up from two different angles, creating a special opportunity to observe the present through the past to consider the future of art.

Under the theme "Storyteller", the exhibition presented a selection filled with chosen artists from galleries in the Asian region. Many of the works portrayed dynamic economic development, social issues, and the post-pandemic situation and present the emotional Asia today. The participating galleries were nca | nichido contemporary art (Tokyo), GALLERY2 (Seoul and Jeju island, South Korea), Sa Sa Art Projects (Phnom Penh, Cambodia), Vin Gallery (Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam), and YIRI ARTS (Taipei, Taiwan). The exhibition consisted of a total of 15 works, including those by remarkable artists. The exhibition included Ngoc Nau, who had a huge impact at this year's Art Basel Hong Kong, Hsieh Jung-Wei, who was selected for the Taiwan Cultural Center's "Made in Taiwan" exhibition, and Chen Hsien Yu, who broke new ground at the "There is another capital beneath the wave." exhibition (Yamaguchi Center for Arts and Media). And these artists' new art works were shown for the first time

Daisuke Miyatsu (AFAF2023 Special Advisor)

Titled 'The Power of Reverberation - Openings from Kyushu,' this booth introduces works by artists who originate from, or who have strong bonds with, Kyushu. Deeply rooted in Kyushu's history and their own diverse backgrounds, these artists have explored various contemporary struggles while resonating and connecting with otherness.

Featured artists included Takashi Kuribayashi, who participated in Documenta 15, a globally renowned international contemporary art exhibition held in Kassel, Germany in 2022, Kaoru Hirano, known for exhibitions at POLA Museum, Hiroshima City Museum of Contemporary Art and Arts Maebashi, and Umi Ishihara, whose works intersect fiction and documentary and recently showcased her work at the National Museum of Art, Osaka.

The participating galleries included ART FRONT GALLERY (Tokyo), GALLERY SOAP (Kitakyushu), WAITINGROOM (Tokyo), and other Kyushu-based and internationally acclaimed artists, totalling more than 20 artworks.
